Please set all recyclables out by 7:00 AM on your designated collection day

The Items Below CAN BE RECYCLED!!!

Food and beverage containers, aluminum cans. Clean and drain all containers

Plastic bottles, jugs and jars. Drain all bottles and throw the bottle cap in the garbage.

Plastic tubs and lids. Clean all food items from the container and separate the lid from the container.

Printed paper. Newspapers, catalogues, magazines, telephone and paperback book, household paper, junk mail and envelopes.

Boxboard cartons and *FLATTENED* Cardboard boxes. Food boxes (*cereal, cookie, frozen food- liners removed*), tissue/shoe boxes, detergent boxes (*clean/empty/flattened*). Small cardboard must be flattened & placed in recycle bin. Flatten large cardboard and place within another cardboard box or place it securely underneath your bin.

The Items Below CAN NOT BE RECYCLED!!!

NO wet news paper

NO GLASS PRODUCTS of any kind.

NO ceramic or pyrex glass

NO light bulbs or mirrors

NO USED OIL OR OIL CONTAINERS OF ANY KIND

NO Polystyrene (Styrofoam)

NO plastic grocery bags

Please no household garbage or non-recyclable items placed in the bins!

Non-recyclable items will be left in the bins
